Discussion Points

This section summarizes each discussion point addressed during the Steering Committee Kickoff Meeting.

Project Scope

Mr. Subbio briefly reviewed the planning process that will be used to update the HMP, as it was described in Tetra Tech's proposal and contract. Mr. Subbio described that the mitigation strategy will be developed based on the results of the risk assessment and capabilities assessment.

Hazards of Concern

The committee discussed hazards that have impacted the County. Attendees identified the following impacts and issues related to hazards:

- Dam Failure and Levee Failure will be profiled separately.
- A tornado recently impacted the County.
- Hurricanes, Tropical Storms, and Nor'easters will not have their own hazard profile. The impacts of these storms will be captured in the hazard profiles related to flood and wind.
- Radon Exposure will not be profiled. There have been no recorded impacts of radon in Somerset County.
- Cyber Attack will be addressed in the Terrorism hazard profile.
- An Environmental Hazard Coal Mining hazard profile will be added.

Planning Team Members

Mr. Subbio described the role of the Planning Team and the organizations to be represented.

Mr. Subbio stated that the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA) and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region III have recently begun to require that municipal authorities and special districts (including school districts) be treated as their own jurisdictions similar to municipalities. These include the Cambria Somerset Authority and the Meyersdale Municipal Authority. Authorities and districts will have to meet participation requirements to be eligible to adopt the HMP and potentially receive mitigation funding.

Ms. Emerick manages the Somerset County Community Organizations Active in Disaster (COAD) and will reach out to member organizations.

Attendees discussed additional stakeholders to involve in the planning process, including the conservation district, chambers of commerce, Norfolk-Southern and CSX, the Meyersdale Area Merchants' Association, PEMA Western Area, the Pennsylvania State Police, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, the National Park Service, the US Army Corps of Engineers, the US Department of Agriculture, the cooperative extension office, the Pennsylvania Department of Health, the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections, and neighboring counties in Pennsylvania and Maryland.

Public and Stakeholder Outreach

Mr. Subbio described methods of outreach that will be used in the planning process. Tetra Tech will develop a project website to which the County website will link. Somerset County DES maintains a Facebook page. Tetra Tech will develop an online mapping tool (Problem Identification Form) through which stakeholders can identify where and how hazards impact their communities. Tetra Tech will develop a set of information-gathering surveys for stakeholders to complete.



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Project Schedule

Mr. Subbio reviewed the project schedule and key milestones. The risk assessment and capabilities assessment will be complete by February 2024. The mitigation strategy will be developed by May 2024. The draft HMP will be complete in June 2024.

Attendees scheduled the Planning Team Kickoff Meeting for 3:00–5:00 p.m. on October 25, 2023.

- Mr. Zearfoss will discuss the planning effort at the Municipal Summit.
- Ms. Emerick will compile records of emergency incidents.

- Tetra Tech will develop the project website.
- Tetra Tech will develop the Problem Identification Form.
- Tetra Tech will develop the stakeholder surveys.
- Tetra Tech and the County will facilitate the Planning Team Kickoff Meeting on October 25, 2023.
- Tetra Tech will continue to profile the hazards of concern.
